Refresh our music strategy, including choir recruitment and training, working with our Director of Music

Some of our plans to do this:

Create a regular social/fellowship provision for people of all ages Recruit a Young People's lead, to devise suitable provision for them, including engagement with other young people in the area, through events for the community and local schools, alongside our junior church Provide a small library of resources for all ages

Continue our shared activities such as our local walks around Sussex

Our Aims:

- Continue to raise profile of Green spaces
- Ensure our building is visible to all within the city
- Develop our relationship with the parish school in partnership with other churches
- Continue to foster high quality weekly recitals
- Offer our church as a multi–use space for cultural and our own spirituality events
- Increase the hours the church is 'open'
- Discern our ministry of hospitality to those in need in the wider community and the city

- I. Green Spaces Co-ordinator continue working with council and groups such as FOSN
- II. School Lead to reinstate regular lay presence in school, e.g. reintroduce the Open Book
- III. People in Need Lead to ensure wider city inclusion

- Embed a rich volunteering culture

- Improve our church and its facilities
- Embed a digital strategy across all church resources
